USA 2008/9 - 13.5%  
🍷 *The long, dry and very hot late summers allow lovely flavours to develop. Vibrant redcurrants and a spiced oak balance.*
- 29 Hardys Oomoo Shiraz, McLaren Vale** £19.95  
Australia 2006/7 - 13.5%  
🌐 *Deep purple, with ripe cherry and blueberry tones, coupled with and enhanced by a refined yet rich, savoury middle palate of dark chocolate, layered with hints of cherry and vanilla oak on the finish.*
- 30 Chianti, Ruffino** £21.00  
Italy 2007/8 - 12.5%  
🍷 *Harmonious and mellow, with violet and red berry notes on a soft and refreshing finish.*
- 31 Don Jacobo Rioja Crianza Tinto, Bodegas Corral** £23.00  
Spain 2005/6 - 12.5% (available by the glass)  
🍷 *Abundant bright raspberry aromas mingle with sumptuous cherries and layered with a creamy barrique character.*

New Zealand 2007/8 - 13.5%  
🍷 *Raspberry sweetness showing through a youthful character, yet more structure and complexity developing from barrique-ageing.*
- 33 Châteauneuf-du-Pape Cuvée Tradition** £45.00  
France 2007/8 - 13.5%  
🌐 *Traditions ensure heady aromas of spices and a long velvet character laden with warm fruit cake flavours.*
- 34 Barolo Lo Zoccolaio, Villa Lanata** £60.00  
Italy 2004 - 13.5%  
🌐 *Specially selected Nebbiolo grapes give heady aromas of violets and bramble berry characters enveloped in large oak barrique complexity, a classic from a top producer.*
- 35 Altos de Corral Rioja, Bodegas Corral** £65.00  
Spain 1998/02 - 12.5%  
🌐 *Rocky soils and low grape yields all contribute to the rich intensity and concentration of strawberries and cream.*

🍷 *Delightful floral combination of Riesling and aromatic Gewürztraminer.*
- 3 Alexis Lichine Colombard-Sauvignon, Côtes de Gascogne** £14.95  
France NV - 11.5%  
🍷 *Lively and aromatic fresh dry white from Gascony*
- 4 Kleine Zalze Bush Vines Chenin Blanc, Stellenbosch** £15.50  
South Africa 2009/10 - 13.5% (available by the glass)  
🍷 *Soft and creamy, a hint of ripe exotic fruit and a delicious vanilla sweetness.*

🍷 *A crisp style with a fresh, yet ripe lemon character with no oak ageing.*
- 6 Fair Horizons Fairtrade Sauvignon Blanc, Western Cape** £16.95  
South Africa 2009/10 - 12.5%  
🍷 *Bright floral aromas with fresh lemon and light tropical fruit and a fragrant clean refreshing finish.*
- 7 Pinot Grigio Provincia di Pavia Terre D'Alteni, La Versa** £16.95  
Italy 2008/9 - 12.5% (available by the glass)  
🍷 *Subtle bouquet of apples and aromatic herbs, the palate is deliciously fresh with a slight richness to the finish.*
- 8 Armidale Estate Hill Grove Unoaked Chardonnay, SE Australia** £17.50  
Australia 2007/8 - 13%  
🍷 *Unoaked, a tropical fruit flavoured wine with notes of spring blossom and honey.*

Italy 2007/8 - 12.5%  
🍷 *Lean, mineral style with a citrus freshness, hints of crushed almonds on the finish.*
- 10 Don Jacobo Rioja Blanco, Bodegas Corral** £18.50  
Spain 2008/9 - 12.5% (available by the glass)  
🍷 *Fresh, dry, crisp and modern, from this classic Spanish region using the local Viura grape.*
- 11 Robert Mondavi Twin Oaks Chardonnay, California** £18.95  
USA 2007/8 - 13.5%  
🍷 *A zesty combination of citrus ripeness and hints of mangos with peaches and an elegant lingering finish.*

Italy 2008 - 12%  
 Grown in a sought after area of Veneto and bottled young to preserve the freshness, hints of figs and ripe peaches.
- 13 Hardys Oomoo Chardonnay, Adelaide Hills** £19.95  
Australia 2007/8 - 13.2%  
 Full-flavoured peachy aromas with great balance, citrus and spice; nicely rounded off with vanilla undertones.
- 14 Chablis, Paul Deloux** £19.95  
France 2007/8 - 12%  
 Flowery, lively, fresh and mouth-watering with a crisp fruity palate and that flinty backbone only found in true Chablis.
- 15 Nobile Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough** £22.50  
New Zealand 2007/8 - 12.5%  
 A rich cocktail of passionfruit, tangerine and ripe peach with an underlying hint of grassy complexity and a crisp, dry, lingering finish.

### EVERYTHING IS ROSÉ

France 2008/9 - 12.5% (available by the glass)  
 Harvested in the cool of the morning and cool fermented in stainless steel tanks to ensure that the flavours of fresh summer fruit are retained in the bottle - delicious.
- 17 Pinot Grigio Rosato del Veneto, Collezione Marchesini** £14.95  
Italy 2008/9 - 12% (available by the glass)  
 Dry and subtly flavoured raspberry and apple-scented rosé from the north-east of Italy.
- 18 Vendange White Zinfandel, California** £17.00  
USA 2008/9 - 11%  
 A brief time with juice and skin together gives this delicate colour, delicious strawberry aroma and zingy freshness.
- 19 Robert Mondavi Twin Oaks Zinfandel Rosé, California** £18.95  
USA 2008/9 - 11%  
 Clean and refreshing delicate rosé with lovely sweet summer-fruits underpinned with jasmine, orange zest and just a splash of honeyed spice.

- 20 La Campagne Cabernet Sauvignon, Pays d'Oc** £14.95  
France 2007/8 - 12.5% (available by the glass)  
 All the classic blackcurrant aromas and flavours, balanced with a soft, tannic finish.
- 21 Kell's Edge Cabernet-Grenache, SE Australia** £14.95  
Australia NV - 11.5% (available by the glass)  
 Fruit-driven and medium-bodied with a spicy, peppery character and soft, juicy tannins. An ideal alternative to 'Old World' wines.
- 22 Tierra Merlot, Maule Valley** £14.95  
Chile 2008/9 - 13% (available by the glass)  
 Ripe blackberry aromas and a subtle underlay of oak with bright, ripe berry flavours and smooth tannins.
- 23 Altozano Tempranillo-Cabernet Sauvignon de Castilla, Gonzalez Byass** £15.95  
Spain 2008 - 14%  
 Rich, juicy plum and blackberry flavours show first, followed by a touch of vanilla spice.
- 24 Berri Estates Shiraz, SE Australia** £16.50  
Australia 2008/9 - 13.5% (available by the glass)  
 Medium-bodied and fruity with raspberry, cherry and plum, complemented by vanilla spices.

- 25 Rare Vineyards Malbec, Pays d'Oc** £16.50  
France 2009 - 13%  
 Having achieved fame in Argentina, Malbec returns home. Lovely violet aromas, solid fruit flavours and a splash of spiced oak.
- 26 Armidale Estate Hill Grove Unoaked Shiraz, SE Australia** £17.50  
Australia 2007/8 - 14%  
 Ripe blackcurrant and bramble fruit, with a hint of black pepper spice on the finish.
- 27 Beaujolais-Villages La Perdrisette, Thorin** £18.50  
France 2007/8 - 12.5%  
 Soft, strawberry fruit on the nose with a silky palate and finish.
